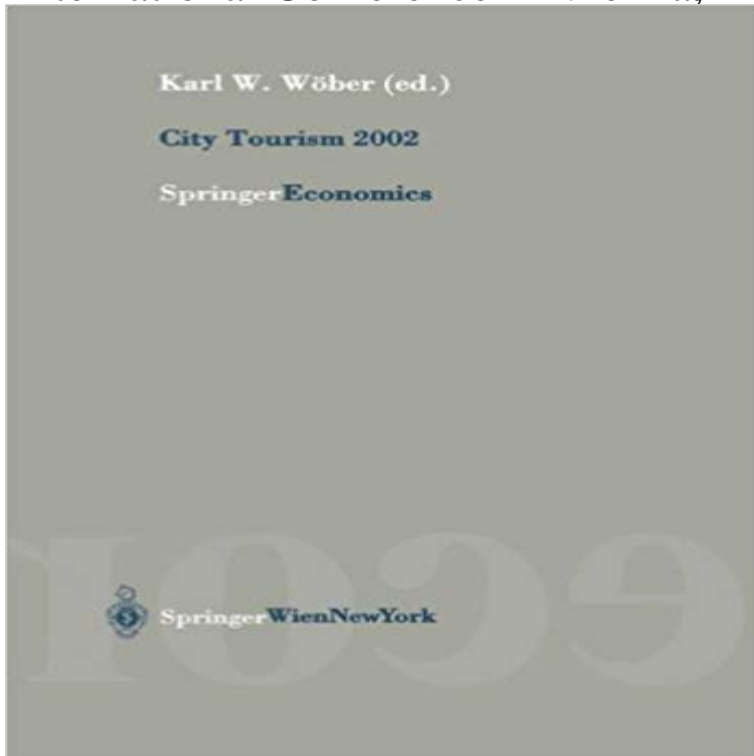


City Tourism 2002: Proceedings of European Cities Tourism International Conference in Vienna, Austria, 2002 (Springer Economics)
