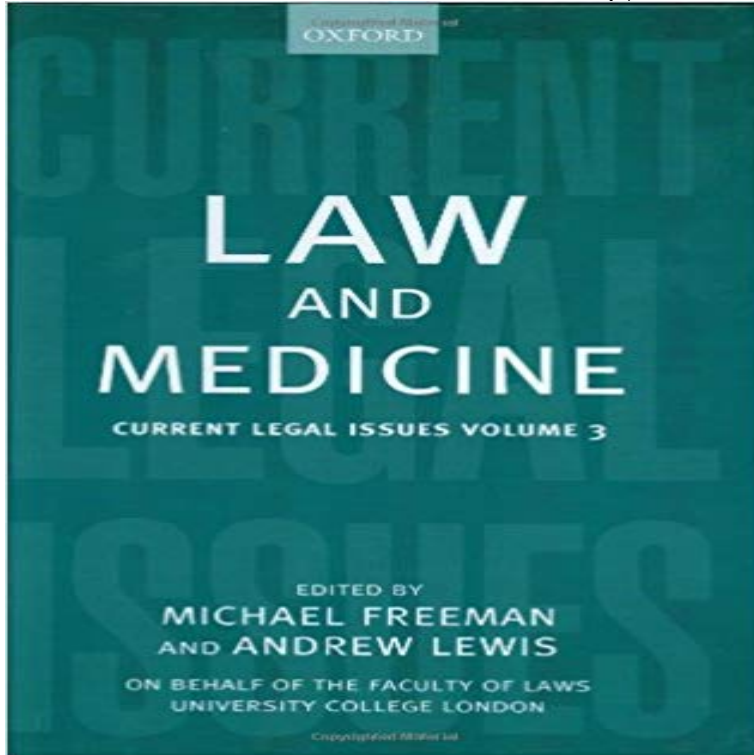


Law and Medicine: Current Legal Issues 2000 Volume 3
