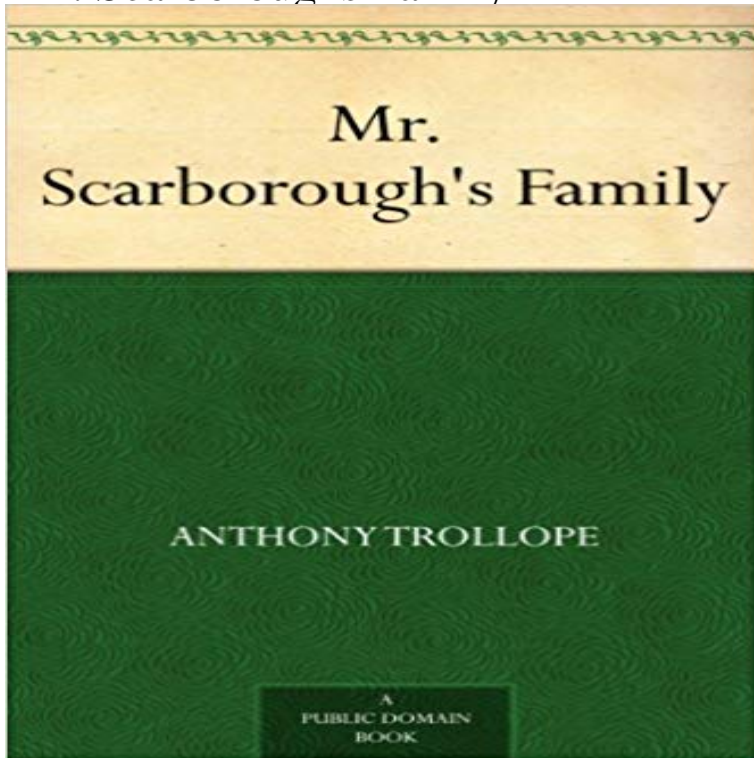


Mr. Scarboroughs Family
