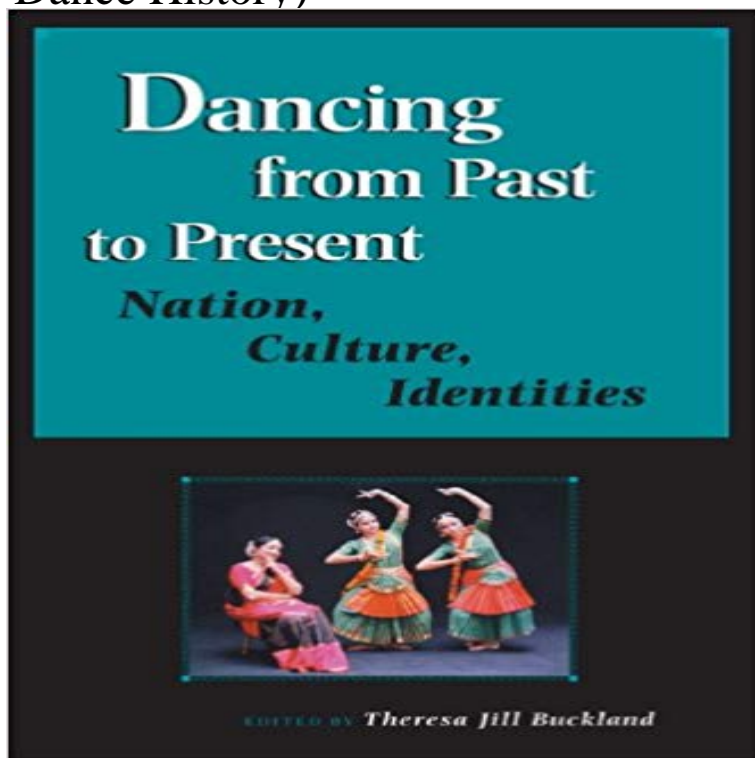


Dancing from Past to Present: Nation, Culture, Identities (Studies in Dance History)
